Futuristic design is also showcased at the ice Q restaurant in Sölden, which featured in the James Bond movie *Spectre*. Its glass facades make the building seem transparent and there are stunning mountain views. For a more earthy, old-style design, opt for Seminarhof Tratzberg. Built entirely from organic wood, the venue offers a retreat-styled experience and is flooded with light.

For a sporting venue with a difference, the Bergisel Ski Jump Stadium in Innsbruck showcases Olympic history and modern design. The first ski jump took place in 1927, while a 50-metre tower, designed by Zaha Hadid, was added in 2002. Available for events, the tower features a restaurant with floor-to-ceiling glass windows and a panorama terrace.
